CONFIDENTIAL SUBJECT: EQUIPMENT TURN - IN

1. (C) THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE IS PROVIDED BY COMMANDING GENERAL AMERICAL AT AMERICAL DIVISION COMMANDERS CONFERENCE ON 19 SEPT. 70 "WHETHER OR NOT THE DIVISION GOES HOME ON THE NEXT REDEPLOYMENT WE WILL MOVE IN SOME MANNER (EITHER REDEPLOYMENT OR COVERING AREAS PREVIOUSLY OCCUPIED BY REDEPLOYED UNITS) IN THE PROCESS OF ANY UNIT OR CP MOVE, EXCESSES IN EQUIPMENT SHOW UP LARGE DOLLAR AMOUNTS OF MONEY ARE REPRESENTED IN UNUSED SPARE PARTS AND EQUIPMENT. RE-DEPLOYMENT IS A LARGE OPERATION AND BECOMES OVERLY COMPLICATED BY EXCESSES IN EQUIPMENT. COMMANDERS ARE ADVISED TO CLOSELY SURVEY ON HAND EQUIPMENT AND TURN IN EXCESSES AS THEY BECOME EVIDENT. A FREE TURNIN POINT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND COMMANDERS SHOULD TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS. CAUTION SHOULD BE EXERCISED IN TURN - IN PROCESS SO AS NOT TO ELIMINATE EXCESSES IN A WASTEFUL MANNER."

2. (U) AN INSPECTION OF REAR AREAS ON 11 OCT 70 INDICATES THAT MUCH UNUSED AND UNNEEDED EQUIPMENT IS STILL ON HAND. THE BDE CO DESIRES THAT EACH BATTALION CO SURVEY HIS REAR AREA AS WELL AS HIS FSB TO IDENTIFY THOSE ITEMS OF EQUIPMENT WHICH ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED OR FOR WHICH THERE IS NO FORESEEABLE USE.

3. (U) THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE APPLIES:

A. THOSE EXCESS ITEMS WHICH ARE NOT PRESENTLY ACCOUNTED FOR ON A UNIT PROPERTY BOOK WILL BE TURNED IN TO THE BDE FREE TURN - IN POINTS A.S.A. P.

B. THOSE UNNEEDED ITEMS WHICH ARE TOE/TOE AND ACCOUNTABLE, WILL BE REPORTED TO THE BDE S-4 BY TELEPHONE, MESSAGE, OR LETTER A.S.A.P.

HHS XDE S-4 WILL IN TURN COMPLETE A BDE LIST OF UNNEEDED TOE/TOE EQUIPMENT AND SUBMIT AN IMMEDIATE REQUEST FOR TURN-IN AUTHORIZATION.

4. (U) PENDING FORMAL APPROVAL OF UNNEEDED TOE/TOE TURN-IN BY HEADQUARTERS, USARV, TURN-IN PROCEDURES WILL CONTINUE UNDER THE ASSUMPTION THAT APPROVAL WILL BE GRANTED.
