1. (C) RECENTLY THERE HAVE BEEN INDICATIONS THAT PREPLANNED AIR STRIKE REQUESTS SUBMITTED TO THIS HEADQUARTERS ARE NOT BASED ON ADEQUATE INTELLIGENCE. IN SEVERAL CASES THE SOLE BASIS FOR THE REQUEST WAS AN AGENT REPORT. WHILE AN AGENT REPORT MAY BE FAIRLY RELIABLE THE REPORT BY ITSELF IS NOT JUSTIFICATION FOR USE OF AN AIR STRIKE. OTHER INFORMATION SUCH AS VISUAL RECONNAISSANCE SIGHTING RECENT CONTACTS URI'S ETC MUST ALSO BE AVAILABLE TO WARRANT USE OF TACTICAL AIR.

2. (C) IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH COMMANDER TO INSURE EFFECTIVE UTILIZATION AND INTEGRATION OF FIRE SUPPORT ASSETS. TO ACCOMPLISH THIS THERE MUST BE A CLOSELY KNIT WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE S2'S, S3'S, AND ARTILLERY REPRESENTATIVES AT BATTALION AND BRIGADE LEVEL. TARGETS SHOULD BE DEVELOPED FROM A CAREFULLY PLANNED TARGET ACQUISITION AND SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM EMPLOYED TO COVER THE AREA OF OPERATIONS AS WELL AS FROM INFORMATION ACQUIRED BY OTHER INTELLIGENCE SOURCES. A WORKING TARGET LIST SHOULD BE DEVELOPED THAT CONTAINS POSSIBLE TARGETS AND CURRENT INFORMATION

EACH ONE WHEN ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONFIRMS A TARGET AS ONE THAT SHOULD BE ENGAGED THE FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATOR ANALYZES THE TARGET AND RECOMMENDS THE TYPE OF FIRE SUPPORT TO BE EMPLOYED. HEAVY ARTILLERY 8 AND 175, WILL BE UTILIZED AGAINST FIXED TARGETS WHEN AN ANALYSIS REFLECTS THAT THIS METHOD OF ATTACK IS THE MOST ECONOMICAL.

3. (C) COMMANDERS WILL TAKE NECESSARY ACTION TO INSURE THAT THEIR FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION SYSTEM OPERATES IN ACCORDANCE WITH GUIDANCE CONTAINED IN PARAGRAPH 2 ABOVE.
