1. (U) SITUATIONC SEE CURRENT INSUM
2. (C) MISSIONC 11TH BRIGADEN IN COORDINATION AND COOPERATION WITH THE 4TH ARVN REGT, AND QUANG NGAI PROVINCE, CONDUCTS SURGE OPERATIONS IN ASSIGNED AO FOR A THIRTY (30) DAY PERIOD BEGINNING 290001 OCT 1970 TO DESTROY VC/VCI.

3. (C) EXECUTIONC

A. CONCEPT OF OPERATION: THIS OPERATION WILL BE CHARACTERIZED BY USE OF US AND ARVN FORCES IN THE FOOTHILLS AND RF/PF FORCES IN THE POPULATED AREAS. IN ADDITION US FORCES WILL CONDUCT COMBINED OPERATIONS WITH RF/PF FORCES

IN THE LOWLANDS. THE OPERATION WILL BE DIVIDED INTO FOUR PHASES OF ONE WEEK DURATION EACH. ADDITIONAL TASKS WILL BE ASSIGNED TO SUBORDINATE UNITS PRIOR TO EACH PHASE. DURING THE INITIAL STAGE OF PHASE I SUBORDINATE COMMANDS OF THE 11TH BRIGADE WILL HACTICALLY EMPLOY THE MAXIMUM FIELD STRENGTH WITHIN THEIR ASSIGNED AOS.

B. 3/1 INFANTRYC

- (1) CONDUCT SURGE OPERATIONS WITH A MAXIMUM OF ONE RIFLE COMPANY IN AREA 1.
- (2) MAINTAIN CONTINUOUS LIASON WITH NGHIA HANH AND TU NGHIA DISTRICTS FOR PERIOD OF THE SURGE OPERATIONM
- (3) PRVVIDE SECURITY FOR ARTILLERY AT NGHIA HANH.
- (4) BE PREPARED TO SECURE OBJECTIVE "P" N CENTER OF MASS BS 485655.

C. 4/3 INFANTRY: OPCON 198TH BRIGADE.

D. 1/20 INFANTRY:

- (1) CONDUCT SURGE OPERATIONS IN AREA 2 AND THE NORTHERN PORTION OF AREA 3.
- (2) COORDINATE WITH MO DUC DISTRICT FOR COMBINED SURGE OPERATIONS WITH RF/PF FORCES IN EASTERN PORTION OF ASSIGNED AO.

- (1) CONDUCT SURGE OPERATIONS IN AREA 2 AND THE NORTHERN PORTION OF AREA 3.
- (2) COORDINATE WITH MO DUC DISTRICT FOR COMBINED SURGE OPERATIONS WITH RF/PF FORCES IN EASTERN PORTION OF ASSIGNED AO.

- (2) FORCES WILL BE IN ASSIGNED OBJECTIVE AREAS NLT 290001 OCT 70.
- (3) OPERATIONS OVERLAY SENT SEPARATELY.

(4) A COMBINED INTERROGATION CENTER WILL BE OPERATIONAL AT QUANG NGAI PROVINCE EFFECTIVE 29 OCT 1970.

(5) THE 11TH BRIGADE WILL OPERATE A LIAISON SECTION WITH THE SENIOR ADVISOR QUANG NGAI PROVINCE EFFECTIVE 281600 OCT 1970

(6) DOCUMENTS AND OTHER ITEMS OF INTELLIGENCE VALUE FOUND ON DETAINEES OR DISCOVERED DURING THE AREA SEARCH SHOULD BE EVACUATED WITH THE INDIVIDUAL TO CICM TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS FOUND WITH CAPTURED EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE EVACUATED WITH THE EQUIPMENT. CAPTURED SIGNAL AND CRYPTOGRAPHIC DOCUMENTS AND EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE TAGGED AND IMMEDIATELY FORWARDED TO THE NEAREST S2/G2 OFFICER FOR FURTHER EVACUATION TO RADIO RESEARCH UNIT.

(7) ULL CAPTURED DOCUMENTS AND ITEMS OF EQUIPMENT SHOULD BE PLACED IN ENVELOPES OR OTHERWISE SECURED, TAGGED TO REFLECT TIME/DATE, LOCATION/CIRCUMSTANCES OF CAPTURE AND CAPTURING UNIT, AND CROSS REFERENCED TO THE DETAINEE EXPW IF APPLICABLE.
