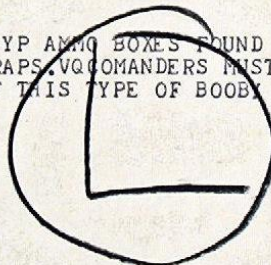

1. THERE HAS BEEN SEVERAL INCIDENTS RECENTLY IN WHICH U. S. TROOPS HAVE BEEN SERIOUSLY INJURED WHEN THEY HAVE PICKED UP AND OPENED ABANDONED M-60 AMMO BOXES. THE ENEMY IS OBVIOUSLY BOOBY TRAPPING M-60 AMMO BOXES AND LEAVING THEM IN AREAS WHERE U. S. TROOPS ARE KNOWN TO OPERATE.

2. ALL ABANDONED M-YP AMMO BOXES FOUND ON FIELD OPNS SHOULD BE TREATED AS BOOBY TRAPS. VQCOMANDERS MUST INSURE THAT ALL PER SONEL MADE AWARE OF THIS TYPE OF BOOBY TRAP AND ENEMY ACTIONS.
