They could not tell if they had any weapons. Artillery was initiated at 1000 as a blocking force. An Air Cav was requested at 1000 and Warlord 23 & 26 were on station at 1034. Warlords reported finding some bunkers. Above element will search the area. (Bde/Annis 23-104) Warlords came on station 1034 and inserted their blue legs along with C Co's element. They searched the area thoroughly with negative results. The Warlords did spot 1 VC/NVA evading to a woodline to the North. He was engaged but neither Warlords or blue leg elements could find him. They were engaged and two VC dropped their packs and evaded to the SW. They left a fresh blood trail and are currently checking this area out. 1 pack was a sandbag with 25 lbs of rice and corn.
