SUBJECT: BATTLEFIELD POLICE (U)

A. REF 11TH BDE OPERATIONAL REPORT LESSONS LEARNED DTD 1 31 OCT 70.

1.

(1. (C) REF ABOVE INDICATED THE PROCEDURE FOR DESTROYING THE RESIDUE OF USED SMOKE GRENADES TO PREVENT THE VC FROM REUSING THE M201A1 FUSE ASSEMBLY FOR BOOBY TRAPS. THE FUSE ASSEMBLY SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THE USED SMOKE CANISTER AND COMPLETELY DESTROYED OR EVACUATED TO THE REAR, THE CANISTER SHOULD BE CRUSHED AND BUREID WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

2. (C) UNITS SHOULD CONTINUE TO EMPHASIZE THE NEED TO POLICE THE BATTLEFIELD TO DENY THE ENEMY MATERIAL FOR BOOBY-TRAPS AS WELL AS TO DENY HIM INFORMATION.
