2. RECENTLY THERE HAS AGAIN BEEN A RASH OF THEFTS IN THE BRIGADE IN WHICH PERSONAL FUNDS HAVE BEEN REPORTEDLY STOLEN FROM UNIT SAFES. IT WOULD ALSO APPEAR APPROPRIATE FOR THE UNIT COMMANDER OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE TO MAINTAIN A REGISTER OR LEDGER INDICATING THE AMOUNTS DEPOSITED OR PLACED IN THE SAFE BY SPECIFIC INDIVIDUALS. FINALLY, ALL SAFES SHOULD BE LOCKED AND LOCATED WHERE THEY ARE UNDER CONSTANT OBSERVATION BY UNIT PERSONNEL AND A RECORD KEPT OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE OR HAD ACCESS THERETO.
