SUBJECT: FLIGHT SAFETY-PASSENGER SECURITY

A RECENT AIRCRAFT ACCIDENT REVEALED THAT RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF SEAT BELTS WERE NOT BEING ADHERED TO WITHIN THE 2ND INF DIVISION. THE CG HAS DIRECTED THAT THE FOLLOWING INFO BE DISSEMINATED TO ALL CREWMEMBERS IMMEDIATELY.

A. AIRCRAFT COMMANDERS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO INSURE THAT THE NUMBER OF OCCUPANTS OF THE AIRCRAFT DOES NOT EXCEED THE NUMBER OF SEATS AND SEAT BELTS AVAILABLE.

B. EACH OCCUPANT WILL BE SECURED BY A SEAT BELT THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE FLIGHT.

C. DOOR GUNNERS AND CREWCHIEFS MAY USE THE AIRCRAFT HARNESS FSN 1680-516-8428 IN LIEU OF SEATBELTS IN A TACTICAL ENVIRONMENT.

D. USE OF SAFETY BELTS MAY BE WAIVED BY THE AIRMOBILE TASK FORCE COMMANDER FOR PASSENGERS DURING TACTICAL OPERATIONS WHEN THE TACTICAL SITUATION SO DICTATES, E.G., COMBAT ASSAULTS.

1. (C) THE AMOUNT OF MUNITIONS TURNED IN UNDER THE VOLUNTEER INFORMANT PROGRAM(VIP

HAS BEEN INCREASING FOR THE LAST THREE MONTHS. THE POSSIBILITY EXISTS THAT SOME OF THESE MUNITIONS HAVE BEEN OBTAINED DIRECTLY FROM ALLIED FIRE BASES, ASP'S , OR OTHER AMMUNITION

STORAGE AREAS. DIVISION ARTILLERY IS INSURING THAT ACCURATE RECORDS OF SPECIFIC LOTS AND QUANTITIES OF AMMUNITION DRAWN BY THEIR UNITS ARE MAINTAINED AND THAT ARTILLERY BATTALIONS CHECK VIP MUNITIONS AGAINST THESE RECORDS.

2. (C) IN A FURTHER EFFORT TO IDENTIFY WHERE SOME OF THIS AMMUNITION MAY BE COMING FROM ,LOT NUMBERS OF UNFIRED ARTILLERY AMMUNITION TURNED IN UNDER THE VIP WILL BE DETERMINED WHENEVER POSSIBLE. THESE LOT NUMBERS WILL BE INCLUDED ON THE REGULAR VIP REPORT SUBMITTED TO G2.

3. (U) ALL BNS AND UNITS ASSIGNED TO THE 11TH BDE WILL MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO IDENTIFY SOURCE OF US AMMO TURNED IN UNDER THE VIP PROGRAM.
