SUBJECT: TACTICAL AIR STRIKES (U)

1. (C) DURING THE PAST WEEK, THERE HAVE BEEN SEVERAL PREPLANNED TACTICAL AIR STRIKES EAST OF QL1. THE BOMB DAMAGE ASSESSMENT (BDA) AS A RESULT OF THESE STRIKES WAS PRACTICALLY NEGLIGIBLE. IN ADDITION AND OF PROMARY IMPORTANCE, TACTICAL AIR STRIKES EAST OF QL1 HAVE AN ADVERSE PSYCHOLOGICAL IMPACT ON THE LOCAL VIETNAMESE POPULACE RESIDING IN THE AREA SINCE THE AREA IS REGARDED AS A SECURE AREA. ACCORDINGLY, TACTICAL AIR STRIKES EAST OF QL1 BY US AIRCRAFT ARE AUTHORIZED ONLY UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- A. IN SUPPORT OF TROOPS IN CONTACT(TIC)
- B. IN SUPPORT OF GROUND OPERATIONS IN WHICH GROUND-FOLLOW UP IS CONDUCTED IN THE AIR STRIKE AREA.

2. (C) AIR STRIKES HAVE NOT RECENTLY BEEN CONDUCTED WITHIN THE DIVISION TAOR IN CONTRAVENTION TO THE NEWLY STATED POLICY. THE POLICY STATED IN THIS MESSAGE WILL BE ADHERED TO.
