2. (C) THE COMBINED MATERIAL EXPLOITATION CENTER(CMEC) TEAM IN DANANG HAS PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE FRNG INFORMATION/EQUIPMENT MOST VALUABLE TO THEM:

A. PROMPT REPORTING AND EVACUATION OF THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF MATERIAL IS DESIRED:

1. NEW ENEMY ITEMS WHICH HAVE NEVER BEEN RECOVERED BEFORE.
2. STANDARD ITEMS, EITHER OF COMMUNIST OR FREE WORLD ORIGIN, WHICH HAVE BEEN MODIFIED BY THE NVA/VC.

PAGE TWO OF TWO PAGES CONFIDENTIAL

3. ANY STANDARD COMMUNIST MATERIAL MANUFACTURED WITHIN THE LAST THREE YEARS.

B. MARKINGS ON EQUIPMENT, ESPECIALLY SERIAL NUMBERS, DETERMINE WHERE THE ITEM WAS MANUFACTURED AND QUANTITY PRODUCED. EXACT REPLICAS OF THE MARKINGS ARE DESIRED WHEN POSSIBLE. 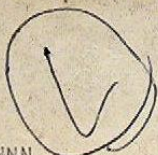
