TRAVELED ROADWAYS TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT CONSISTENT WITH REQUIRED OPERATIONS. US PERSONNEL WILL NOT APPEAR AT ANY PUBLIC GATHERINGS IN 23D INF DIV TAOI.

2. (C) VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WILL BE MINIMIZED THROUGHOUT THE 23D INF DIV TAOI FROM 031200 JAN 71 TO 050800 JAN 71. VEHICLE TRAFFIC ON HWY 518 THRU QUANG NGAI IS PROHIBITED DURING THIS PERIOD.

3. (U) ESSENTIAL VEHICLE TRAFFIC (I.E. SUPPLY CONVOYS, EMERGENCY VEHICLES) WILL CONTINUE TO SUPPORT DIVISION OPERATIONS ON A RESTRICTED BASIS. ALL CONVOYS MUST BE APPROVED BY THIS HEADQUARTERS. MAXIMUM USE OF AIR SUPPORT IS ENCOURAGED DURING THIS PERIOD.

4. (U) REDUCED EXPOSURE DURING THIS PERIOD IS DIRECTED TOWARD PREVENTING INCIDENTS.
