THE OFFICE OF THE ORGANIZATION SECTION WAS COMPRISED OF 1 LEAF ROOFED BUILDING WHICH WAS 10 METERS LONG & 4 METERS WIDE. THE BUILDING WAS DIVIDED INTO 3 ROOMS. THE ORGANIZATION SECTION HAD THE FOLLOWING MSNS (1) TO REORGANIZE ANY WEAK INSTALLATIONS IN THE FOLLOWING VILLAGES DURING THE 1ST STAGE (OF 1 MONTHS DURATION): DUC PHONG (V) AKA DUC THUAN BS780510; DUC LAN (V) AKA DUC MY BS750490; & DUC CHANH (DUC HOAI) BS740610.

IN ADDITION, THE ORGANIZATION SECTION ALSO WAS TO ORGANIZE SEVERAL PENETRATION OPERATIONS IN THE GVN- CONTROLLED AREAS IN ORDER TO COLLECT INFO OF GVN ACTIVITIES & TO TO PROPAGANDISE AGAINST THEIR (GVN'S) POLICES.
