At 0920H FAC (HELIX 26) put in an AS vic BS442798 destroying 30 M of trench and 2 structures. The fighters drew SA fire as they made their passes fr coord BS442800. At 1030H Rcn plat at coord BS458795 detained 1 VCS F and had 1 US WHA fr a booby trapped hootch. The US WHA was treated and released on LZ BUFF. At 1250H Co B at BS451798 found and destroyed 30 ft of tunnel after searching it with neg res. At 1450H Co C at coord BS425800 spotted 9 VC in the open and then obs them as they ran into the rice paddies and finally into a wooded area. One or two VC had wpns and some had packs. Arty was called in but res are unk. At 1645H Co D at coord BS452- 802 spotted 6 NVA, with wpns and packs, evade into a hootch. Arty and An AS were called in with re unk. At 1815H Rcn plat at coord BS472790 found 64 cans of fish and 4 cans of condensed milk; and at coord BS465792 found a 50 Cal MG pos.
