At 0650 Co C reports negative results from previous nights claymore detonation (See #15). At 0945 at BS624336 FAC saw 3 personnel in field, bunkers approx 200 meters away (See #22). At 0855 at BS624341 Co C observed and engaged VC/NVA evading. They pursued at which point they engaged the enemy resulting in 2 VC/NVA KIA (See #23). At 1450 and 1600 sensor activation BS658376 resulted in unknown nr of personnel, confirmed by metal, engaged with quad .50 cal and 4.2 inch mortars with unknown results. (See #40, 41). At 1900 at BS717373 Co B had a mech ambush detonate, believe set off from stormy weather. (See #50). There were negative further significant events during the day.
