## AMERICAL DIVISION NEWS

CHU LAI (AMERICAL IO) -- Action inoreased in the Americal Division's subern I Corps Tactical Zone yesterday as Division forces and supporting elements accounted for 63 VC and 11 NVA: killed, 12 individual and four crew-served weapons captured.

Action increased sharply in Operation Champaign Grove yesterday as elements of the 1st Scdn., 1st Armored Cav's "Dragoons" and supporting elements counted for 45 VC and seven NVA killed, 12 individual and four crew-served wea-

pons captured.

"C" Troop and "B" Troop, 1st Sqdn. 1st Armored Cav. engaged an .unknown sized enemy force late yesterday about five miles southwest of Quang Ngai City. "C" Troop accounted for 42 killed, seven AK-47 rifles, one 7.62mm pistol, and one RPG-7, and one RPG-2 captured. "B" Troop accounted for three VC killed.

"Frofessionals" of a 1st Bn., 46th Inf. company under operational control of the 1st 3qdn., 1st Armored Cav., killed seven NVA, captured four AK-47 rifles, and two RPG-2s yesterday about five miles

west of Quang Ngai City.

. 11th Inf. Bde. soldiers and supporting helicopter gunships reported 15 VC and four NVA killed and six suspects detained yesterday in scuthern and western Quang Ngai Province.

"hero Scouts" gunships from the 123d Avn Bn. killed five VC and four NVA soldiers while supporting "Jungle warriors" of the 11th Inf. Bde. in Operation Champaign Grave west of Guang Ngai City.

"Cld Guard" soldiers from a 4th Bn., 31 Inf. company commanded by CPT Jimmy R. Davis (Denton, Tex.) continued to search the area where they had found a complete 105mm howitzer Thursday, Yesterday they uncovered 100 rounds of M-60 ammunition, one B-40 rccket, asserted NV. and khaki uniforms, and energy documents in a small tunnel nine miles west of: Cueng Nged City. The Wold Guard W. soldiers later killed nine VC in the same area.

In the Duc Pho area 1st Bn., 20th Inf. scldiers killed one VC yesterday morning and recovered his pistol belt and two grenades while conducting a combat sweep 13 miles north of: Broncc.

The two 18-year-old liontagnords who led a 4th Bn., 3d Inf. company to a buried 105mm hewitzer of mean Quang col Thursday, each received 25,000 plasters yesterday as part of the Voluntary Informant Program.

JENUSIUM-Six houses were blown up on the Gaza Strip Thursday in a punitive action against Arab commandos, reliable Israeli sources said.

Three houses were blown up kednesday for the same reason, the sources said. Two of the houses were in Hebron and one in Nablus.

About 165 buildings have been blown up by Israelis in occupied Arab territry since the June, 1967 war.

In Nablus, Mayer Hamdi Canan resigned after protesting Israelipolicy toward the occupied west bank of the Jordan kiver.

Canan was mayor of Nablus for five years. His term was to have ended last September but the Israeli government responnted him.
