CHU LAI (AMERICAL IO) -Action was light and scattered yesterday in the Americal Division's southern I Corps Tactical Zone as . Division forces and supporting elements accounted for 13 VC. killed and two individual weapons recovered.

"Charger" units of the 196th Inf. Bde, killed eight VC and recovered two individual weapons in scattered action in operation wheeler/wallows yesterday.

In two separate actions a 3d Bn., 21st Inf. company killed a total of three IC in an area 14 miles west of Ten ky.

another "Gimlet" company 4th Bn., 21st Inf. killed one evading WC with small arms fire eight south of Hoi An.

The Bie. command and control heli-copter killed three evading VC 19 miles West of Tan Ky.

Bie. aerial observers called artillery on suspected VC locations miles northwest of Tam Ky, killing one

Action slowed yesterday as one VC was killed in the 198th Inf. Bde's, area of operations.

"hero Scouts" of the 123d Avn. Bn. working south of Che Lai engaged two VC killing one. Four hand grenades recevered from the VC's body.

Six suspects were detained yesterday by "Brave and Bold" soldiers and supporting units. AR'N troops operating with a lst Bn., 52d Inf. campany detrined three suspects in two separate incidents. All three of the suspects were cerrying weapons. a 1st Bn., 6th Inf. company commanded by CPT Thomas K. Chapman (Schofield Barracks, Hawaii) detrined one wounded suspect in the "rocket ridge" ares west of Chu Lei. "Aero Scouts" detained two additional suspects.

Division forces suffered one soldier killed and four wounded and evacuated for medical treatment.
