

1. (C) EFFECTIVE WITH THE JANUARY 1971 SOI, EACH FREQUENCY WILL BE ASUIGNED A SEPARATE CALLWORD. THIS ACTION NECESUARY TO PRECLUDE MULTIPLE FREQUENCY CHANGES RESULTING FROM CALLWORD COMPROMISE.

2. (C) ABOVE SOI CHANGE WILL AFKECT ALMOST EVERY UNIT IN THE DIVISION. EARLY NOTIFICATION IS BEING SENT TO INSURE DISSEMINATION TO ALL RTO'S AND TO FOREWARN UNITS OF THE POTENTIAL CALLWORD COMPROMISES THAT WILL OCCUR IF RADIO OPERATOR'S DO NOT EMPLOY CORRECT PROCEDURES.
