REF COMUSVACV MESSAGE, DTG 100914Z DEC 70, THE INDISCRIMINATE FIRING OF WEAPONS, DISCHARGING OF ORDINANCE DEVICES AND THE EXPLODING OF FIREWORKS IS PROHIBITED THROUGHOUT THE SOUTHERN SECTOR, I MILITARY REGION, YEAR ROUND. HOWEVER, SINCE THE CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR SEASON IS TRADITIONALLY A TIME OF HIGH ENTHUSIASM, ACCENTUATED BY INCREASED OUTBURSTS OF WEAPONS FIRING AND EXPLODING OF FIREWORKS AND ORDINANCE DEVICES, PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO THIS PROHIBITION IS NECESSARY AT THIS TIME.

2. COMMANDERS ARE REQUESTED TO AGAIN ADVISE ALL PERSONNEL OF THE ABOVE PROHIBITION. IN ADDITION, COMMANDERS WILL TAKE POSITIVE ACTION TO ENSURE SUCH INCIDENTS DO NOT OCCUR, PAYING PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO PERIMETER BUNKERS AND GUARD POSTS.

COMMANDERS ARE ENJOINED TO GIVE CONTINUED EMPHASIS TO THEIR TRAFFIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS, ESPECIALLY IN THE AREA OF SENIOR OCCUPANT RESPONSIBILITY.

3. MILITARY POLICE WILL CITE BOTH THE DRIVER AND THE SENIOR OCCUPANT IN EVERY CASE OF:
A. EXCESSIVE SPEED

1. (C) EFFECTIVE WITH THE JANUARY 1971 SOI, EACH FREQUENCY WILL BE ASSIGNED A SEPARATE CALLWORD. THIS ACTION NECESSARY TO PRECLUDE MULTIPLE FREQUENCY CHANGES RESULTING FROM CALLWORD COMPROMISE.

2. (C) ABOVE SOI CHANGE WILL AFFECT ALMOST EVERY UNIT IN THE DIVISION. EARLY NOTIFICATION IS BEING SENT TO INSURE DISSEMINATION TO ALL RTO'S AND TO FOREWARN UNITS OF THE POTENTIAL CALLWORD COMPROMISES THAT WILL OCCUR IF RADIO OPERATOR'S DO NOT EMPLOY CORRECT PROCEDURES. FOR EXAMPLE, THE CURRENT (DECEMBER) SOI REFLECTS THE SAME CALLWORD FOR THE DIVISION COMMAND-SECURE, OPERATIONS-SECURE, AND INTELLIGENCE-SECURE NETS, EVEN THOUGH THESE NETS OPERATE ON DIFFERENT FREQUENCIES. RTO'S NOW ENTER EACH NET USING THE SAME CALLWORD. THE JANUARY SOI WILL REFLECT A SEPARATE CALLWORD FOR EACH NEO. THUS, WHEN RTO'U HAVE
