SUBJ: MAGNESIUM BATTERY BS4386 (U)

1. (C) MSG CG USARN 101509Z FEB 70 SUBJ AS ABOVE IS QUOTED FOR YOUR INFO AND ACTION.
2. (C) SEVERAL INSTANCES HAVE BEEN REPORTED WHERE THE KY 38 CASE HAS RUPTURED WHEN IN OPERATION WHILE USING MAGNESIUM BATTERY BS4386. IT APPEARS THAT THIS OCCURS AS A RESULT OF HYDROGEN GAS GIVEN OFF BY THE BATTERY DURING PROLONGED PERIOD OF OPERATION.
3. (U) CAUTION SHOULD BE EXERCISED WHEN USING KY38 WITH BS4386. USAECOM AND CLSC-V REPS ARE INVESTIGATING THE PROBLEM. AS AN INTERIM PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE, RECOMMEND THE BATTERY CASE BE OPENED BEFORE THE KY38 IS PLACED IN OPERATION. DURING PROLONGED PERIODS OF OPERATION BATTERY CASE SHOULD BE OPENED AT LEAST EVERY TWO HOURS WHERE FEASIBLE TO RELEASE ACCUMULATION OF GAS.
