1. THIS MESSAGE IS RETRANSMITTED.
2. TO INSURE THAT ALL POSSIBLE MEASURES ARE BEING TAKEN TO PRECLUDE LOSS OF LIVES AND EQUIPMENT AS A RESULT OF ENEMY MINES EMPLACED ON ROADS, THE FOLLOWING MEASURES WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY COMMANDERS PRIOR TO ROAD USE BY AMERICAL DIVISION VEHICLES:
 - A. SWEEP OF THE ENTIRE ROAD WILL BE MADE USING MINE DETECTORS. THE MINE SWEEP TEAM WILL ALSO PERFORM A VISUAL RECONNAISSANCE.
 - B. PRESSURE TEST TRUCKS WILL BE USED BY ALL MINE SWEEP TEAMS. PRESSURE TEST VEHICLE WILL BE A 5 TON DUMP TRUCK LOADED TO CAPACITY WITH LATERITE OR SAND AND CARRY ONLY THE DRIVER. TEST TRUCK WILL

BE BACKED ALONG THE ROADWAY APPORXIMATELY 50 TO 100 METERS BEHIND THE MINE SWEEP TEAMS. ALL PERSONNEL WILL REMAIN CLEAR OF PRESSURE TEST TRUCK WITH A SAFETY RADIUS OF AT LEAST 50 METERS.

- C. THE 26TH ENGR BN WILL USE THE MINE ROLLER IN CLEARING HL 518 AND OTHER KEY ROADS WITH FREQUENT MINE INCIDENTS WHEN AVAILABLE.
- 3; THIS MESSAGE DOES NOT AFFECT CURRENT MINE SWEEP PROCEDURES ON QL-1.
