SUBJECT: FIRE SUPPORT PLANNING

1. (U) THIS MESSAGE IS RETRANSMITTED.

2. (C) DURING THE PAST TWO MONTHS THERE HAVE BEEN A SERIES OF CONTACTS THE RESULTS OF WHICH INDICATE THAT THE FINER POINTS OF FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION BETWEEN THE ARTILLERY, ARMY AVIATION, AND AIR FORCE HAVE BEEN LOST. THERE ARE ALSO INDICATIONS THAT THE PRIOR PLANNING NEEDED TO CONDUCT A SUCCESSFUL COMBAT ASSAULT OR GROUND ATTACK, WITH APPROPRIATE FIRE SUPPORT HAS BEEN IGNORED.

3. (C) THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS WILL BE TAKEN BY ALL BRIGADE COMMANDERS:

18 A. PRESENT A CLASS ON FIRE SUPPORT COORDINATION TO ATTALION COMMANDERS AND KEY STAFF PERSONNEL. REPRESENTATIVES FROM ARTILLERY, ARMY AVIATION, AND THE AIR FORCE WHO NORMALLY SUPPORT THE BRIGADE WILL BE PRESENT TO ASSIST AND ANSWER QUESTIONS.

B. FOLLOWING THE BRIGADE CLASS, EACH BATTALION COMMANDER WILL CONDUCT A SIMILAR CLASS FOR COMPANY COMMANDERS AND MEMBERS OF THE BATTALION STAFF.

C. UPON COMPLETION OF THE REQUIRED CLASSES, EACH BRIGADE WILL PLAN AND EXECUTE A COMMAND POST EXERCISE (CPX), WITH EACH BATTALION TO INCLUDE THE USE OF NORMAL COMMUNICATIONS. THIS CPX SHOULD BE DESIGNED TO INSURE THAT ALL NECESSARY PERSONNEL ARE FULLY AWARE OF THE PLANNING AND PRACTICAL STEPS REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFULL FIRE SUPPORT.
