1. (C) REF STATES THAT UNDER ENSURE 257 THE XM96 TACTICAL CS2 ROCKET HAS BEEN DEVELOPED. THIS ROUND WILL PROVIDE A LIGHTWEIGHT DELIVERY OF 227 GRAMS OF CS2 TO A POINT OR AREA TARGET BY AN INDIVIDUAL USING THE XM202 LAUNCHER A COMPONENT OF THE XM191, MULTISHOT PORTABLE FLAME WEAPON.

2. (C) THE ROUND WAS DEVELOPED TO PROVIDE A NONLETHAL MEANS OF CLEARING BUILDINGS, BUNKERS AND CAVES AND TO PROVIDE LIMITED AREA TARGET CAPABILITY.
